Newpark School Sports Centre was opened in 1973 and has been available for public use since then. Facilities which have all recently been renovated include a 25 metre indoor heated swimming pool, health suite-sauna & steam room, a multipurpose sports hall, fully equipped fitness centre, outdoor playing pitches and a theatre/conference room. Pool activities available at Newpark Sports Centre range from; masters training sessions, public swimming, club, swimming training, adult and children's swimming lessons to Aqua fit classes. A full range of fitness classes such as kettlebells, TRX/Rip-60 suspension training, fitbox, bootcamp, circuit training, spinning and body toning classes and a fully equipped fitness Centre, ensures that every fitness request is catered for.

Over 500 people representing 135 companies attended the glitzy, black-tie ceremony in competition for one of only 26 awards presented. The Master of Ceremonies was Chicago based keynote speaker, author and business humourist Conor Cunneen; Irishman Speaks.
