

 Arts Week activities happen in school. The students have been given a the information in their OneNote all the times and venue. This info is available on the App and the web site.


 This year again we are theming our Arts week to give it cohesion and everything produced will be on display on TY Graduation at the end of the year. Thursday May 22nd 2020

 Please be punctual and attend EVERY day otherwise you and your group will miss out.






- In Dublin Week has a variety of exciting activities this year.

- If a student is late please let the school know IMMEDIATELY so that groups are not waiting for someone who is not coming / can make arrangements to wait for someone.






- Bus departs from school at 7:30am on Monday morning.
