State Examinations, 2022

Incidental Inspection, May 2022

The Board acknowledges all involved in the incidental inspection from the Department of Education Inspectorate which took place in May 2022. The focus of this incidental inspection was on the area of wellbeing. Two classes of SPHE and one class of Art were observed, along with a Level 1 Child Protection check. The inspector described her experience of teaching and learning during her visit as both interesting and enjoyable. In light of the impact of Covid-19 on classrooms nationwide, the Inspectorate is keen to promote the reintroduction of *active student engagement* and *collaborative student work* in lessons and both these good practices were observed during the inspection.

Whole School Assembly & Prize Giving, 2022

The Board welcomes the return of the end of year Whole School Assembly and Prize Giving held on 18th May 2022. It is an important annual school event, which while functionable online, serves the School better when in-person. Appreciation was expressed to the parents of both the head girl and head boy for presenting the academic and extracurricular prizes on the day. It was also noted that the 4th year and 6th year graduation services were held again in the GPA this term on the 24th and 19th May respectively. Both events were well attended and enjoyed by students, parents/guardians and teachers alike.
