

# Newpark Comprehensive School Board of Management Agreed Report for School Community September 2022

## **Leaving Certificate**

The Board acknowledges the considerable success and achievement of students in the Leaving Certificate 2022. The percentage of candidates falling into each CAO points band compares favourably with previous years and with national percentages. The Board acknowledges and thanks teachers for their contribution to the achievements of students in the Leaving Certificate examinations 2022 and all those involved in the facilitation of the examinations this year.

## **Child Safeguarding**

The Board conducted its annual review of the School's Child Safeguarding Statement & Risk Assessment and adopted a revised document for the academic year 2022/2023. This document is published on the School website and on the noticeboard in the School lobby. All members of the School community are hereby notified of the updated document. Both the Student Council and the Parent Teacher Association are invited to submit feedback in relation to the School's compliance with 'Child Protection Procedures for Primary and Post Primary Schools 2017'.

## Admission to First Year 2023/2024

The Annual Admission Notice in respect of admissions to the 2023/2024 school year is published on the School website, along with application information for the forthcoming school year. The School will commence accepting applications for admission to first year 2022/2023 on 3<sup>rd</sup> October 2022 and cease accepting applications on 28<sup>th</sup> October 2022.

## Covid-19 Response

While most remaining Covid-19 risk mitigation measures have been wound down, the requirement to implement good infection prevention and control measures such as hand hygiene, respiratory hygiene and cleaning currently remains in place. Likewise in relation to good classroom ventilation practice. #### **Hockey Pitch Redevelopment**

Formal approval was received in July 2022 from the Department of Tourism, Culture, Arts, Gaeltacht, Sport and Media for the Sports Capital Programme grant (2018/2019 application), with works mooted to begin in September 2022. Unfortunately, due to supply chain issues the installation works are currently delayed.



#### **School Self-Evaluation**

As 2022/2023 has been designated a review year in light of the impact of Covid-19, the focus for SSE for this year is *Consideration and Planning for the Introduction of One-to-One Devices* and *Managing Student Anxiety within the School Community*.

## Adjustment to State Examination Assessment Procedures, 2022/2023

The Minister for Education recently announced the continuation of adjustments to assessment arrangements for students due to sit state examinations in 2023, to take account of the disruption to their learning during the Covid-19 pandemic. This document is published on the School website.

#### **Extra-Curricular Activities**

The appointment of ECA coordinators for both sports and arts/culture is a positive development. Strong numbers of boys and girls are participating in rugby, hockey and basketball at the start of this year. This includes first-year students, which is to be welcomed. The presentation of the Erasmus+ Project of the European CNC-Network's *Magical Moving Machine for Europe* in the Lexicon Library, Dun Laoghaire on 27<sup>th</sup> September 2022 is the culmination of a project involving Newpark and schools from Germany, Croatia, Portugal, Italy and Slovenia. Senior drama auditions for *Romeo and Juliet* are ongoing. The outdoor table tennis table is a pleasing addition to the campus. The contribution of the PTA in hosting the annual Debs reception is to be acknowledged and the return of this event for the Class of 2022 is welcomed.
