Data Protection Policy

The Board reviewed and approved the School's Data Protection policy. It will be posted on the School website accordingly.

Hockey Pitch Redevelopment

The Board regrets that the proposed works to resurface and develop the hockey pitch continue to be delayed. Both Newpark and Avoca remain committed to the project and continue to liaise with the project managers and the contractors with the intent of progressing the project satisfactorily.

Parent/Guardian Teacher Meetings

It is intended that Parent/Guardian teacher meetings will be held in-person in school this academic year. The sixth-year meeting took place successfully on 17th October 2022. The third-year meeting takes place on 15th November 2022 and the schedule for all other meetings is communicated to parents/guardians via email and the School website.

Foreign Language Assistants

The School is pleased to have been allocated both a French and a German language assistant this academic year. The collaboration between the Department of Education, Post-Primary Languages Ireland (PPLI) and the School's Modern Foreign Language Department leading to the success of this scheme is appreciated.

Student Wellbeing

Having delivered a whole staff seminar in August, Dr. Claire Hayes is returning to the School in November to hold a session with the Year Leaders, Student Support Team and AEN Team Leads. She will return for another whole staff session in March 2023 and it is hoped some student sessions in the new year. The Parent Teacher Association (PTA) is engaging Dr. Hayes in the new year for a parent/guardian presentation, with a follow-up online course. *Managing Student Anxiety within the School Community* is an important initiative under the School Improvement Plan this year, in line with Circular Letter 0056/2022 *School Self-Evaluation: Next Steps September 2022 – June 2026*.

Junior Certificate

It has been confirmed by the State Examinations Commission that Junior Certificate examination results will be issued on 23rd November 2022.
