Special Needs Assistant Policy

Student Wellbeing

As part of the School's post-pandemic response to managing student anxiety, the third and final planned staff session with Dr Claire Hayes took place at a whole staff meeting on 7th March 2023. Dr Hayes also addressed all parents and guardians at a PTA organised session on the evening of Tuesday 28th February. There were over 200 parents/guardians in attendance at this session. The online program is now available to all senior cycle students and to all parents and guardians. Dr Hayes will address all junior cycle students over three sessions in March during *Wellbeing Week*.
